Michael Schrage, being first duly sworn, on his oath, states:

1. I am currently the City Manager of the City of Salina, Kansas, ("City of Salina") and have held that position for approximately two (2) years.
2. Before serving as the City Manager of the City of Salina, I served as the interim City Manager of the City of Salina and the Deputy City Manager for a combined total of thirteen (13) years.
3. In my capacities as City Manager, interim City Manager, and Deputy City Manager, I am knowledgeable of the City of Salina's disaster preparedness planning efforts and directives



and designations from the governor of the state of Kansas (the "Governor"), more generally, related to such disaster preparedness planning.

4. In those same capacities, I am generally familiar with the ordinances, resolutions, and declarations made by the City of Salina staff and by the members of the city commission of the City of Salina.


5. The Governor has not determined that the City of Salina needs a disaster agency of its own (i.e., a disaster agency separate from Saline County, Kansas).

6. The City of Salina has not established a "disaster agency" pursuant to the Kansas Emergency Management Act.

7. The City of Salina has not declared a "state of local disaster emergency," as that term is defined and used by K.S.A. 48-932, arising from or relating to the COVID-19 pandemic.

8. The City of Salina has not been subject to such a declaration between November 23, 2020, when City of Salina Ordinance 20-11045 was enacted and the signing of this affidavit.
